

## Rural Municipality of Rosemount No . 378

### Policy No. 15

**The Council for the Rural Municipality of Rosemount No. 378 will instruct the appointed weed inspector to inspect any property in the municipality that has, what council determines to be, an excess amount of weeds. Any property that has been left out of production and/or has not been maintained enough to control the weeds is subject to an inspection by the weed inspector. All land owners are expected to control the weeds on their property and take the necessary steps to prevent the spread of the weeds onto neighboring property. If no weed control has been attempted by the 15<sup>th</sup> of July in any given year, the weed inspector will be instructed to do an inspection of the property and enforce *The Noxious Weeds Act 1984*.**
